THE VIRGINIA GILPIN DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD GUIDELINES – 2018

INTRODUCTION

The Virginia Beach Rescue Squad Foundation, Inc. is an organization dedicated to maintaining a volunteer-based rescue squad in Virginia Beach, Virginia, which provides free pre-hospital emergency care to the City. The Virginia Gilpin Distinguished Service Award is an annual award given by the Foundation to an individual whose outstanding actions and activities have helped to strengthen and enhance the volunteer rescue squad system in the City of Virginia Beach.

ELIGIBILITY

- Any operational, administrative or life member affiliated with any volunteer rescue squad in the City of Virginia;
- A member of the Volunteer Rescue Squad Foundation;
- Any private citizen.

NOMINATION PROCESS

Anyone may nominate an individual to receive the Virginia Gilpin Distinguished Service Award. Completed nomination forms, which are forwarded via email or by fax, must be in the Virginia Beach Rescue Squad Foundation Office no later than 5:00 p.m., November 25, 2018.

SELECTION PROCESS

The President of the Board of the Virginia Beach Rescue Squad Foundation shall appoint three to five members from the Board of Directors to serve on the Award Selection Committee. The Award Selection Committee will review all nominations and will recommend up to four nominees to the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall choose the award recipient at its annual meeting in December. The Executive Director of the Virginia Beach Rescue Squad Foundation will contact the nominee after the decision has been made.
